ATC PTSC Meeting Minutes

November 10, 2015

I. Call to order

Andie Manzanares called to order the regular meeting of the Academy for Technology and the Classics PTSC at 5:42pm on November 10, 2015 at Real Burger Santa Fe.

II. Roll call

III. Principal Update – Susan Lumley

- a) Wednesday, November 18th the 9th through 12th graders will go to a viewing of the original Star Wars at the Violet Crown to celebrate their excellent PARCC scores. A later visit is being planned for the 7th and 8th grade students.
- b) Individual student PARCC scores arrived at ATC on November 10th and will be mailed home to parents shortly.
- c) A special event is being planned for the ATC Girls Cross Country Team as they are state champions this year!
- d) The Foreign Language teachers are wondering if they can participate in Light Up the Night with international foods. Light Up the Night is a school community and fundraiser for the PTSC which originally began to honor the victims of Sandy Hook, but has continued annually. PTSC, students, teachers and families sell crafts, art and food.
- e) ATC will not have graduation in the convention center this year. Other venues are being considered. Perhaps the Scottish Rite temple, the Lensic or the Opera.

- c) Prizes were not distributed for the fall festival costume contest due Mr. Seyfried's discretion (lack of timely communication from Student Council). There were 3 winners. PTSC will now provide the funds for the movie gift cards.
- d) Jennifer Cintas is playing a major role this year in helping the Student Council. Currently she's helping with Turkey Grams.
- e) Student Council was wondering if there could be a prize for the class with the most participation for pajama spirit day. Jennifer and Susan will help decorate a spirit stick to give to the winning class (and to be handed on at the next such event).
- f) The Student Council is working on a Breakfast Club where they would sell breakfast items at ATC a few mornings a week.
- g) There is talk of a salad petition to let Ms. Lumley know how many students would purchase a salad from the lunch truck if they offered them each day.
- h) ATC didn't place in the Celebrate My Drive contest.
- i) There is talk of a Buddy Program, partnering middle school students with high school students for mentoring.
- j) There will be a Homecoming Dance (to celebrate the girls and boys basketball teams) on December 4th in the Phoenix Center. It is open to the entire ATC community.
- k) The Winter Formal (for 9th 12th graders) will be January 23, 2016. They are looking for a venue possibily the Scottish Rite Temple.

 Lisa may not be able to help out with Fab Friday sales after the holidays, as her work schedule is changing. Student Council can help, as can other students who need community service hours.

VI. PTSC Update – Andie

- a) Farolito Sales Vicki and Andie will rally enthusiasm among the faculty at the next meeting (11/11/15). Each Crew class who **SELLS** a minimum of 35 dozen bags will get \$250 from the PTSC for classroom supplies. There will be a pizza party for the crew class from each grade who **SELLS** the most bags. Video on how to fold farolito bags will be uploaded to the website shortly. - b) Open House for Lottery Applicants PTSC will sell nachos (and possibly cookies and cider).
- c) Light Up the Night A meeting is needed to organize this event.

 - **b.** PTSC will sell nachos and frito pies.
 - **c.** Language classes can provide desserts from different countries.
 - **d.** There will be a \$10 booth fee and artists and crafts-persons may sell their goods with a 10% donation of proceeds to ATC.
