Meeting Minutes

February 29, 2016

I. Call to order

Andie Manzanares called to order the regular meeting of the Academy for Technology and the Classics PTSC at approximately 5:30pm on February 29, 2016 at Real Burger Santa Fe.

II. Roll call

The following persons were present: Andie Manzanares, Susan Lumley, Vicki Hutchison, Jennifer Cintas, Lisa Lucero and Laura Cooley.

III. Principal Update – Susan Lumley

- a) The ATC lottery is done. Monday, March 7 is Admission Confirmation day. We have 70 new 7th graders & 27 new 9th graders. ATC could have up to 400 students next year. Unfortunately there is no money to grow the school – for teachers or space.

IV. Student Council & Dance Committee Update – Jennifer Cintas

- a) The Yule Ball was a grand success! Thanks to PTSC for their help with the dance.
- b) The Prom will be held at the Scottish Rite Temple as well this year! [Saturday, May 14th from 8pm to 11pm]. Setup for the Prom will go from 10am to 2pm. The PTSC will sell drinks at the Prom. There was a discussion of having Andie and David set up a photo booth - \$10/photo pre-pay. Photos to be available after editing at ATC for pick-up.
- c) There will be a Sadie Hawkins Dance for the middle school students on March 18 at ATC.
- d) Student Council is selling shamrock shakes for St. Patrick's Day. They are making plans for De-Stress Day – some time before or during the AP Exams (May 4 – 13). AP Exams are \$90 each. Scholarships are available for those taking several exams – from funds raised by the National Honor Society.
- e) The Tiki Tango will be April 22nd.

VI. PTSC Update – Andie

- a) Pi Day, March 14. This is being organized by Dr. Brown and Ms. Gardner. There will be a pie throw. Details about the event are still coming in. PTSC usually sells small pies. This year there is a move to raise funds for student calculators. It was decided

that the PTSC will sell small pies, donate a portion of the sales to the calculator fund and then match the money raised (also for the calculator fund).

- b) The top crew teachers who helped with Farolito Sale will each get a stipend for classroom supplies from the PTSC. There will be a pizza party for the top selling crew classes (from each grade) on March 24th.
- c) Flaming Chicken Run – April 23rd – the Saturday after Earth Day. The FCR now has a logo and donations are being solicited for prizes. Organizers have been assigned duties, guests have been invited, the website is in place and regular meetings are taking place.

V. Funding Approvals

- a) Prom damage deposit – the PTSC & Scottish Rite Temple will use the \$1000 check from the Yule Ball deposit for the Prom damage deposit. The deposit will be returned.
- b) The pole vault for Coach Host has arrived.
- c) Funding was approved, \$100, for Mr. Carlseo for food at the W21 Art & Music Show this Saturday.
- d) There was discussion of a kite project for Ms. Shain's 10th grade classes who are reading *The Kite Runner*. Funding may be solicited at the next meeting (or possibly before via email).
- e) Funding was approved for a cake for Ms. Cermanski's baby shower (approx \$40)
- f) There was talk of prizes for Forensics Week at ATC – but no vote was taken yet.
- g) Funding of \$450 was approved for breakfast burritos for approximately 150 students on the mornings of PARCC testing (grades 7 – 11 will be testing).
