

ATC PTSC

I. Call to order

V. PTSC Update and Business –

- October Wrap Up:
 - Fab Friday, Sweets and Treats, Fall Fest, Halloween Dance all successful
- Winter Calendar:
 - Farolitos - 1am -12noon. PTSC has folded bags left over from last year. ATC will be building Farolitos on Thursday, December 14th from 4-6pm. It will be determined which students will be allowed to fold bags for community service time. Some ideas for

this include: college crew classes to pick a grade level to fold bags, or to have the honor society take the opportunity. Discussed allocating the money raised to help pay for student AP testing. Discussed using a visual thermometer showing the goal for fundraising to place at the entry of the school.

- Light Up the Night will take place December 7th. There will be a Craft fair at which ATC PTSC will charge \$25.00 per booth for vendors. Booths will open up to ATC community first and then to the general community. Luminarias with S'mores and a Basket Raffle are some of the planned activities.
